You need a unique voucher every time you go to Southend Foodbank. Get a voucher or a voucher code before you go to a foodbank session. You can only use each voucher once.

Over 150 local organisations offer foodbank vouchers. If you've had a voucher before and need to come back, talk to them about getting a new voucher. You should use your voucher within 90 days. Please take some ID with you.

Citizens Advice attend foodbank sessions at Ferndale, Belle Vue, Eastwood, Westcliff, Shoebury and Earls Hall, except on bank holidays.

Southend Foodbank provides food for people in crisis. A foodbank parcel includes enough for 3 days for your household, with food for breakfast, lunch and dinner to make at home from tins and packets.

bring your own bags. backpack, shopping bag on wheels etc. if you can
